Format WAG

"1" to "4" are building the team, the best 3 scores are counting. The 5th gymnast is allowed to perform as "5" for her AA-Result.

White Tape is allowed. Additional Mats allowed on FX.

Format MAG "1" to "5" are building the team, the best 3 scores are counting. The 6th gymnast is allowed to perform as "6" for his AA-Result.

Additional Mats allowed on FX, SR, VT, PB, HB

Warm-Up-Times

20 min General Warm-Up (Subdivision 2+3 in Traininghall) WAG: 10 min Warm Up on each Apparatus MAG: 60 min Warm Up on Apparatus

Line-Up

- Line-Up in the middle of the hall for Marching In.
- Marching In of the judges
- Marching In of the teams on to the floor
- Opening Adress
- March to the first Apparatus.

Podium / Corner

Only the active gymnast and coach (1 or 2 – following Technical Regulations FIG) are allowed to be on the Podium. All the other stay in the Corner – we allow up to three coaches per team in the corner.
