Accreditation will be upon arrival in the competition venue.

Valid FIG Trampoline Code of Points, Time of Flight, FIG tie-break rules for Qualifying Round and FIG requirements for first routine will be applied.

75% of all starters in each category – min. four (4), max eight (8) – will advance to the final.

In the finals the IOC tie-break rules for individual competition will be applied.

Medical Services will be provided during the whole event.

In case a visa is required to enter Austria the Austrian Gymnastics Federation will be happy to assist each delegation with an official invitation (reference no.), provided that the request is made before **24**th **August 2014** with the respective form. The request must include the <u>function</u>, <u>full name</u>, <u>gender</u>, <u>date of birth</u>, <u>place of birth</u>, <u>home address</u>, <u>citizenship and passport number</u>, <u>passport expiry date</u>, the <u>arrival</u> and departure dates of each Delegation Member.

The Host Federation and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations

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are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The Organizers will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the Organizers in advance.

Difficulties:

Comp. 1/2: according to FIG 11-12 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only two (2) elements allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. 1 element landing on the front of the body
- 4. 1 element landing on the back of the body

Comp. 3/4: according to FIG 13-14 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. 1 element landing on the back of the body
- 4. 1 element landing on the front of the body
- 5. back somersault with full twist

Comp. 5/ 6: according to FIG 15-16 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. one (1) element either landing on the back or front of the body





















- 4. Full (back somersault with 1/1 twist)
- 5. Rudi or Rudi ball out, (front somersault with 1 ½ twist or 1 ¼ from back, with 1 ½ twist)

Comp. 7/8 according to FIG 17-18 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. one (1) double front or back somersault with or without twist
- 4. one (1) element with a minimum of 540° of twist and minimum of 360° somersault rotation.
- 5. one (1) element to front or back
- 6. one (1) element from front or back in combination with requirement No. 5

Comp. 9/10: FIG A according to Code of Points

-12 years: 1,5 pts.

13-14 years: 1,7 pts.

15-16 years: 1,8 pts.

17-18 years: 1,8 pts.
